Searching for another Gardener or two for SAUC

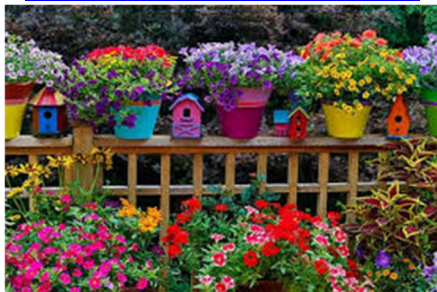
Myra Avey is retiring from all gardening duties this year. She truly needs a replacement or two. She will stay on until September to show people the ropes!

ENFRANCHISEMENT

When it became apparent that Indians were not taking up enfranchisement as expected, the govt. ramped up its efforts with the 1880 amendment to the Indian Act. It now required compulsory enfranchisement for anyone who obtained a university degree or became a clergyman. The Superintendent General may give him a suitable allotment of land from the lands belonging to the band of which he is a member. Source: *21 things*
