DOCTRINE OF DISCOVERY, 1493

Following Columbus 1492 voyage, Pope Alexander VI issued 4 orders (papal bulls) which became the Doctrine of Discovery. This order gave the majority of the Americas to Spain. While most European powers disagreed with the surrender of such large expanses of land to the Spanish, they agreed with the idea of being able to claim land for their nations by “discovering” “new” lands. They redefined discovery and what was required in order to claim lands for a specific nation, thereby shaping the principles which would become the Doctrine of Discovery.

[The Scribblers Story \(opens in a new tab\)](#), a new Christian children’s podcast, just might be the answer.


