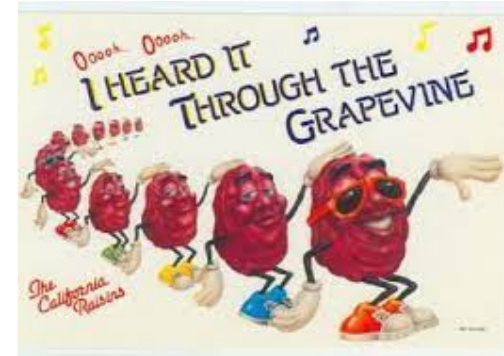

In the same way that forced attendance is normalized for Seepeetza, so is the hard labour and hunger that is part of her RS school experience. By 1958, the focus of RS curricula had shifted from trades instruction to academic instruction. However, students at KIRS continued to perform all the domestic work require to maintain the institution. School officials force the children to prepare food, clean lavatories, dust, sweep, and scrub and polish floors, while feeding them poor quality food in quantities sufficient to ward off starvation, yet still keep them in a continual state of hunger.

Outreach:

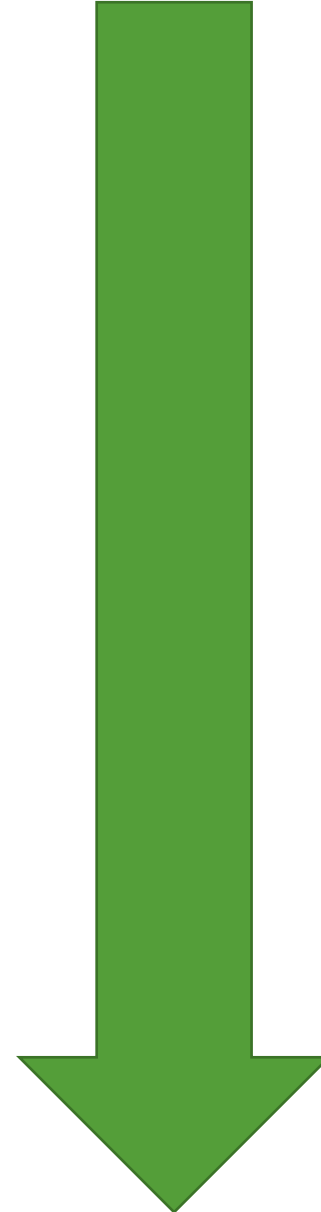

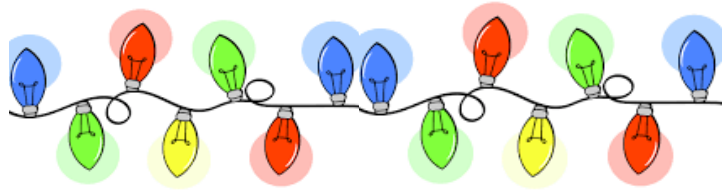
Outreach thanks you for your generosity!
